THE POSITION

We are currently looking for a certified **Water Quality Technician** to join our Texas team. This position accomplishes a variety of duties related to the daily operation of wastewater and water treatment.

THE DAY-TO-DAY

- Flush water lines as needed to improve water quality.
- Open and close fire hydrants.
- Note repairs needed on any equipment or pipes and prepare work orders as appropriate.
- Perform field lab tests to check residuals.
- Other duties as assigned.

¹ While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear. The employee is frequently required to stand, walk, climb stairs or ladders, sit, use hands and fingers, handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, and crawl. The employee may regularly lift 10-25 pounds and may occasionally lift and or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include the ability to distinguish color, close vision and distance vision. The employee must be able to operate electric motors fueled by gasoline, diesel, or gaseous fuels, paint, and other hand tools required. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is routinely exposed to a variety of outside weather conditions, including very hot temperatures as well as snow and ice. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
